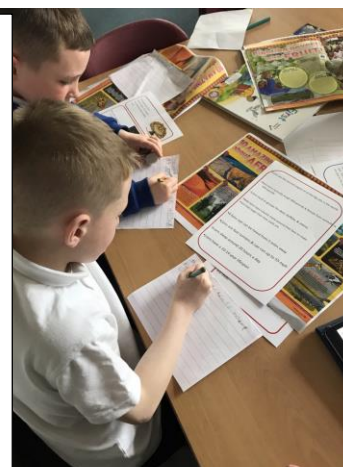
We are aiming for all of our pupils to achieve an average of 96% attendance a year (9 days absence).
