Dear Parents / Anwyl Rieni

I hope this week's newsletter finds you well.

Now school has returned to as close to normal as it has been for a while, I wanted to quickly clarify for you the key information parents across Wales receive when contacted by Track and Trace. Parents are contacted by Track and Trace either directly or via their child's school. The emails / texts which Track and Trace send, inform parents that their child has been identified as a close contact of someone who has had a confirmed PCR test and they contain three main messages; 1) Your child can still attend school; 2) Be vigilant of any symptoms your child may display and keep them off school if they are ill; 3) As it is possible to have Covid-19 and be asymptomatic, it is advisable to give your child a lateral flow and / or a PCR test if you wish to. I hope the above helps if, and when, you receive information from track and trace but please feel free to contact us if you receive a message and you are unsure how to proceed.

Bydd 'Track and Trace' yn cysylltu â rhieni naill ai'n uniongyrchol neu trwy ysgol eu plentyn. Mae'r negeseuon e-bost / testunau y mae 'Track and Trace' yn eu hanfon, yn hysbysu rhieni bod eu plentyn wedi ei nodi fel cyswllt agos â rhywun sydd wedi cael prawf PCR positif, a'i fod yn cynnwys tair prif neges; 1) Gall eich plentyn ddal i fynychu'r ysgol; 2) Byddwch yn wylidwros o unrhyw symptomau y gall eich plentyn eu harddangos a'u cadw ffwrdd o'r ysgol os yw'n sâl; 3) Gan ei bod yn bosib cael Covid-19 heb ddangos symptomau, fe'ch cynghorir i roi llif ochrol a / neu brawf PCR i'ch plentyn os dymunwch.

Rwy'n gobeithio bod yr uchod yn helpu os, a phryd, rydych chi'n derbyn gwybodaeth gan 'Track and Trace' ond mae croeso i chi gysylltu â ni os ydych chi'n derbyn neges a'ch bod yn ansicr beth i'w wneud.

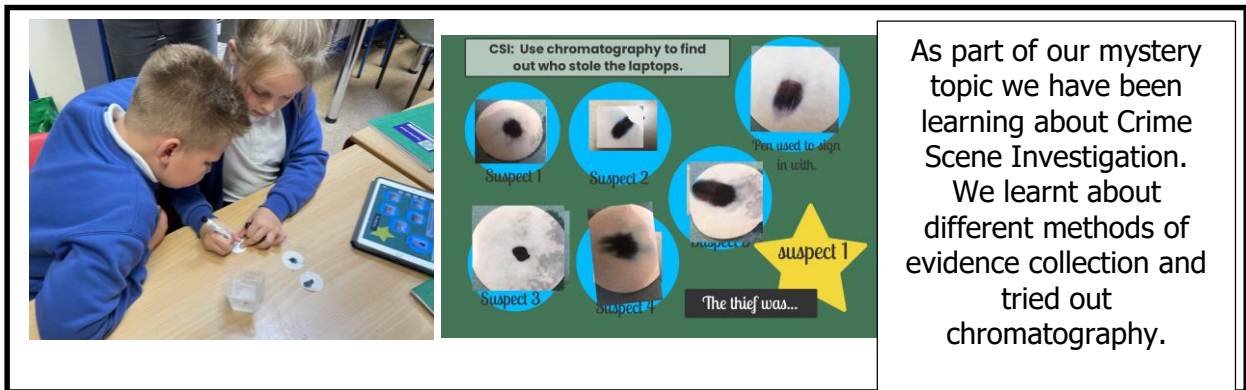
